

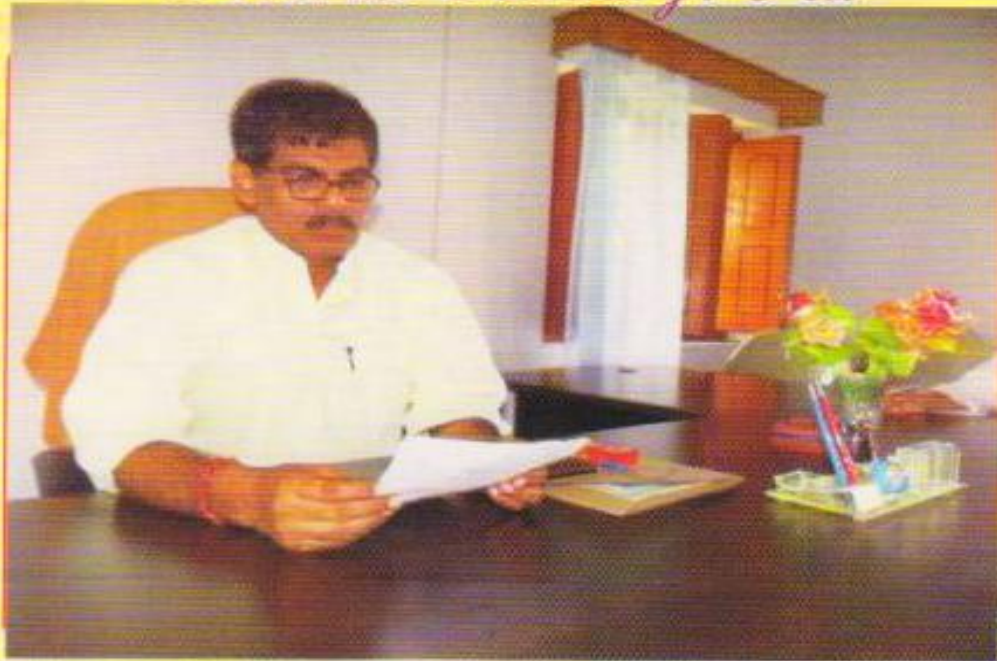

## STUDENT'S INFORMATION

### Application Form

Application form for admission to one year B.Ed. (Bachelor of Education) course in NTTTC and NWTTC respectively are invited on the prescribed form (Enclosed as per demand in this prospectus) for the session. However sell of one year M.Ed. course form at NTTTC will be notified later on at the college notice board.

The cost of B.Ed. form will be rupees 550/- in cash or rupees 600/- by post to admission In-charge, Nalanda Teacher's Training College" or "Nalanda Mahila Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya", Biharsharif, Nalanda. Demand Draft will be made in favour of Nalanda Teacher's Training College and Nalanda Mahila Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya respectively payable at Biharsharif.

### Eligibility for BEd Course

- ✍ Graduate with 50 % Marks in any discipline.
- ✍ Final year Bachelor Degree Students who have appeared for their final examination may also apply. They need to submit a valid degree at the time of admission.
- ✍ Only girl candidates are eligible at NWTTC.

### ADMISSION

Selection of candidates for admission to one year B.Ed. course may be done on the basis of written test or their academic scores and personal interview or as per the college notifications.



## Counseling and Interview

- ✦ Counseling and Interview will be conducted for the selected eligible candidates at Nalanda Teacher's Training College or Nalanda Mahila Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya, Biharsharif.
- ✦ Selection of candidates shall be made strictly as per the rules of college and guidelines of University.
- ✦ No candidates can claim admission as a matter of right.
- ✦ The qualified candidates are required to take admission within a week after the publication of merit list.

## Documents Required

- ✦ Three passport size photographs (write your name and date of birth on the back).
- ✦ Proof of date of birth (Secondary school certificate)
- ✦ Certificate and mark sheets of the matriculation, intermediate, graduation and post-graduation degree.
- ✦ Original College Leaving Certificate/University Leaving Certificate.
- ✦ Original Character Certificate.
- ✦ Original Migration Certificate (for student seeking admission from another university).
- ✦ Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC) from competent authority for candidate seeking admission on reserve quota if any.

✓ **Note:** All academic certificates in original are required for verification at the time of Interview. All photocopies attached should be attested by Gazetted Officer.

✓ **Note:** According to NCTE rules students can not go for any kind of course other than B.Ed. course after getting admission. It is unlawful (strictly not allowed) to sit for any examination of state service, private service or any other university or board after admission in B.Ed. programme. In case anyone found guilty the admission will be cancelled from the immediate effect. Any candidate who has been employee in any state service or any other kind of job will have to submit the releasing /leave order from head of concerned organization at the time of admission.



### Payment of Fee

- ☞ The fee for one year B.Ed. Course is Rs. 65500/- only (Rupees Sixty Five Thousand Five Hundred only). The total amount can be paid by cash at college counter or by Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Nalanda Teacher's Training College" or "Nalanda Mahila Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya", Biharsharif accordingly.
- ☞ The fee for one year M.Ed. course is Rs. 75500/- only ( Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Five Hundred only). The mode of payment will be notified later on at NTTC notice board.
- ☞ The total fee has to be deposited at the time of admission or as per the consideration of Principal.
- ☞ Enrolment (Registration) and University examination fee are to be paid separately as per the college notice.
- ☞ The college management reserves right to revise the fee structure at any time.

### Identity Card

A photo identity card will be provided to the students at the time of admission, which will be valid for one academic year (session). The students are required to produce identity card on demand.

### Dress Code

- College uniforms are available from the college counter on prescribed fee.

### Hostel Facility

Well furnished hostel facility (under separate management) is available separately for boys and girls near the college campus at concessional rate. Hostel admission form can be obtained at college office. It is advised to get admission at an early date in hostel to the various candidates coming from distant places.



## Transport

Transport facility for the students is available from city on nominal charge.

## Library

The college library is having rich collection of course books, manuscripts, reference books etc. on various subjects. Modern aids of teaching like video and audio CDs are also available in sufficient numbers which are easily accessible to the students. To keep in pace with changing scenario the library is equipped with latest computers and high speed internet connection.

## ICT Lab

ICT lab facilities are available with high speed internet connection for language learning and computer learning separately. ICT facilities are -- Computer; Internet Access; Television; Tape Recorder; Radio; OHP; Head Phone; Digital Camera; Mike; LCD Screen; Transparency Screen; Slide Projector; CD Player; CCTV Camera; Sound speaker; Amplifier; Automatic Slide Projector; Microphone; LCD and LED Projectors; Educational CDs; DVD Players; Charts; and Models are present. (Hardware and Software Aids).

## Course Curriculum

The M.Ed. course curriculum as intended will be based on the guidelines as provided by Magadh University, Bodh-Gaya.

The B.Ed. course curriculum is based on guidelines based on Magadh University, Bodh-Gaya. The course is essentially a mix of theory and practical elements to develop knowledge, skill, and attitude. The programme consists of 10 papers of 100 marks each, which includes seven theoretical and three practical papers.

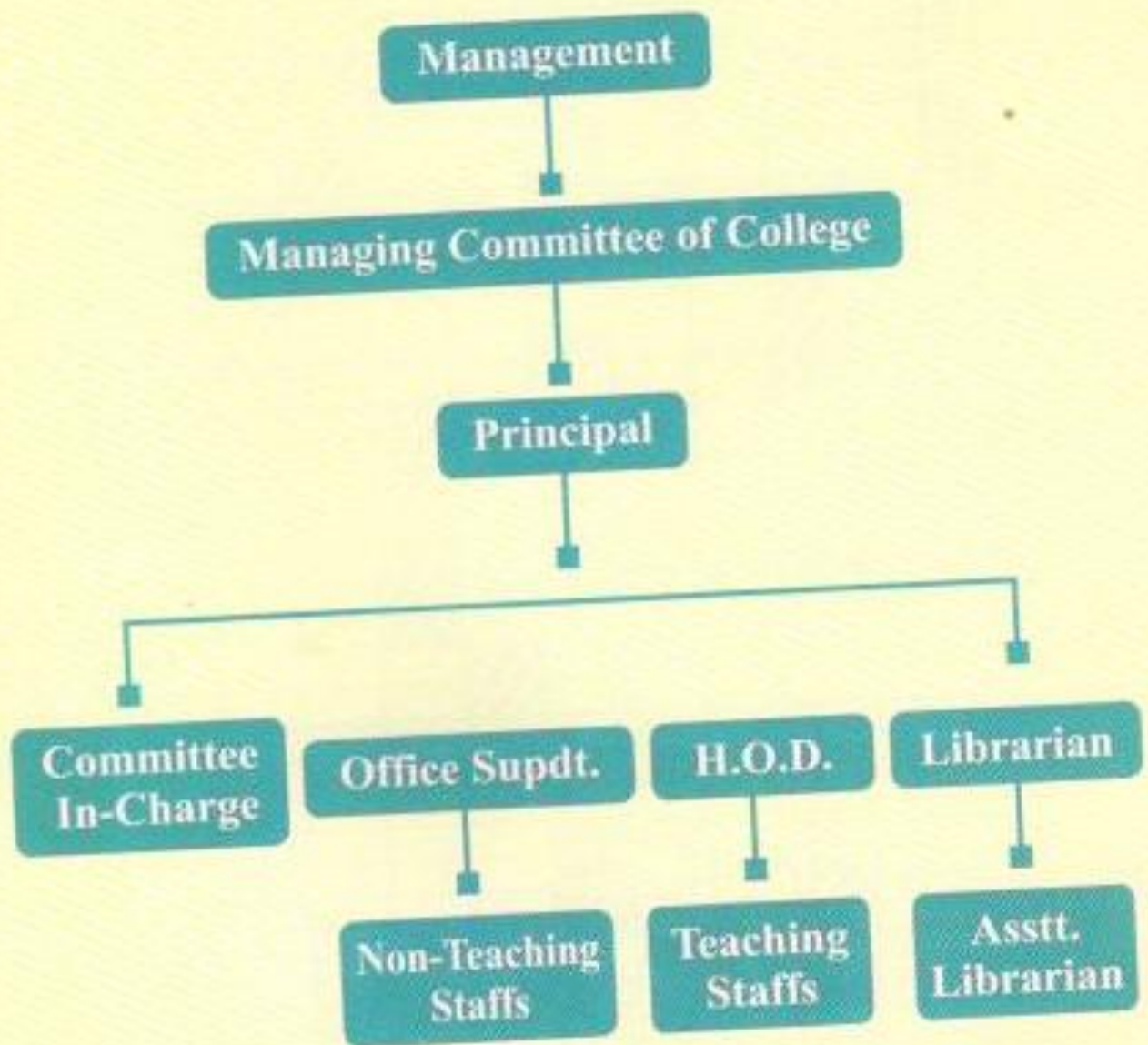

## Places of Interest

Nalanda itself deeply engraves behind a glorious past. The ruins of famous Buddhist Learning Centre at Nalanda dates back to 5th AD(almost 1700 years), which was first residential international university of the world. The knowledge and wisdom had been deeply rooted as envisaged by the ruins and here at Nalanda Group of Institutions will have reminiscent the same to our students to hone them into a professional. We hope that during course study, you will like to visit and enjoy near by monuments & historical places that will leave you with lingering memories and an emblazing career to cherish it for lifetime.

### Nalanda

Nalanda is famous as the ancient seat of learning. The ruins of the world's most ancient University lies at this place. Gautam Buddha visited Nalanda several times during his lifetime. Hicun Tsang stayed here in the 7th century AD and left an important description of the excellent education system and purity of monastic life which were practiced here. He also gave a vivid account of the ambiance as well as the architecture of this unique University of ancient times. In this first residential university of the world two thousand teachers and ten thousand monk students from all over Buddhist world lived and studied. The Gupta king patronized these monastery build in old Kushan architectural style, in a row of cells around a courtyard. Visit of Nalanda Museum and Nav Nalanda MahaVihar in addition to the great ruins of Nalanda provide much information and inspiration.

### Rajgir

Rajgir is a very scenic place. Being located in a valley, Rajgir is surrounded by temples and monasteries. Rajgir was capital of the Magadh Mahajanpad (State) when Patliputra was not subsisted. Rajgir or Rajgrih means the home of Royalty. Buddha not only spent many years in Rajgir but also delivered sermons here. He proselytized emperor Bimbisar at the Griddhakoota hill. The Jivekarmavan monastery was the favorite residence for Buddha. Bimbisar gave Venuvan Vihar to Buddha for his residence. The teaching of Buddha was penned down at Rajgir and it was also the venue of his residence and also the venue of the Buddhist Council. Today, Rajgir has come up as one of the most important pilgrimage for the Buddhist. Ghora Katora lake at this place attracts tourist for their natural beauty and bird sanctuary. The Rope Way to Shanti Stoop at Ratnagiri also attracts tourists.



## Pawanpuri

Lord Mahavira, the final Tirthankar and founder of Jainism, breathed his last at this place, around five thousand B.C. A marble temple, The Jal Mandir, built in the centre of a pond, has been a major pilgrim spot for Janis. Another Jain temple called Samosharan is also located here.

## Bodh-Gaya

Bodh-Gaya is one of the most important and secrete Buddhist pilgrimage centre in the world. It was here under a Pipal tree, the Boddhi Tree, Gautam Buddha attained the supreme knowledge to become Buddha, the Enlighten One. Ashoka (234-198 B.C.E.) contributed tremendously toward the revival, consolidation and the spread the original religion- The Buddhism. Here Ashoka built monasteries for the Buddhist monks and a pillar known as Ashokan Pillar erected to commemorate his conviction for this religion. Now-a-days there is a magnificent Mahabodhi temple and the tree from the original sapling still stand at this place. Recently various Buddhist nations have erected temples at Bodh-Gaya which have been worth visiting.

- सूचनाओं एवं जानकारी को प्राप्ति सुनिश्चित करने हेतु जिस अधिकार की आवश्यकता है वह सूचना का अधिकार है।
- यह पारदर्शी शासन हेतु नागरिकों को प्राप्त अधिकार है।
- इस अधिकार को ही सुनिश्चित करने हेतु भारत को संसद ने "सूचना का अधिकार अधिनियम 2005" पूरे भारत में प्रभावी बना दिया है।

### सूचना कैसे प्राप्त करें?

- सार्वजनिक कार्यालय एवं सरकारी कार्यालयों में विभिन्न स्तरों पर कार्यरत जनसूचना अधिकारी व सहायक जनसूचना अधिकारी सूचना प्राप्त करने का मुख्य स्रोत है।
- सूचनाओं को सुलभ तरीके से आम जनता को उपलब्ध कराना सूचना के अधिकार के अधिनियम 2005 के प्रावधानों के अंतर्गत प्रत्येक कार्यालय के लिए अनिवार्य है।
- सूचना प्राप्त करने के लिये लिखित रूप में या इलेक्ट्रॉनिक माध्यम से हिंदी या अंग्रेजी या फिर सरकारी भाषा या क्षेत्र की भाषा में जन सूचना अधिकारी को मांगी हुई जानकारी का विवरण करते हुए प्रार्थना पत्र लिखें।

### किस तरह की सूचना प्राप्त की जा सकती है?

- सूचना के अधिनियम के अंतर्गत ऐसी सूचनाएँ जो जन हित व राष्ट्रीय हित में हैं एवं सरकार की पहुँच में हैं वो प्राप्त की जा सकती हैं।
- सरकार के सभी विभागों के कार्यकलापों, स्टाफ, वेतन, कर्तव्य तथा योजनाओं-परियोजना के ऊपर खर्च की गई धनराशि का पूरा विवरण और अन्य आवश्यक सूचनाएँ प्राप्त की जा सकती हैं।

### सूचना के आवेदन का जवाब या मांगी गई सूचना के प्राप्ति की अवधि?

- 30 दिन, अगर मामला जन सूचना अधिकारी के पास दर्ज हो।
- 35 दिन, अगर मामला सहायक जन सूचना अधिकारी के पास दर्ज है।
- 48 घंटे, अगर सूचना किसी व्यक्ति के जीवन और स्वतंत्रता के बारे में हो।

### सूचना न मिलने पर या सही सूचना मिलने पर क्या करें?

- यदि 30 दिन के अन्तर्गत सूचना प्राप्त नहीं होती तो सम्बंधित विभाग में निवृत्त प्रथम अपील को अपील कर सकते हैं और यदि प्रथम अपील के बाद भी सूचना नहीं मिलती या आप संतुष्ट नहीं हो तो केंद्रीय सरकारी विभागों के लिए केंद्र सूचना आयोग तथा राज्य सरकारी विभागों के लिए राज्य सूचना आयोग में द्वितीय अपील कर सकते हैं। इसके अलावा शिकायत होने पर सीधे सम्बंधित सूचना आयोग से शिकायत दर्ज करा सकते हैं।

### बैंड का प्रावधान?

- यदि केंद्र सूचना आयोग या राज्य सूचना आयोग को किसी शिकायत या अपील पर निर्णय करते समय पता चलता है कि केंद्रीय जन सूचना अधिकारी या राज्य सूचना अधिकारी ने किसी आवेदन को लेने से मना किया है या समय सीमा के अंतर्गत सूचना उपलब्ध नहीं करवाई है या किसी प्रकार का पक्षपात किया है या गलत सूचना दी है तो अधिकारी को सूचना मांगने हेतु प्रस्तुत आवेदन स्वीकार करने या मांगी गई सूचना उपलब्ध करवाने की तारीख तक सम्बंधित जन सूचना अधिकारी पर प्रतिदिन 250 रुपये के हिसाब से व कुल 2500 रु तक की पेनल्टी का प्रावधान है।

### सूचना कौन प्राप्त कर सकता है?

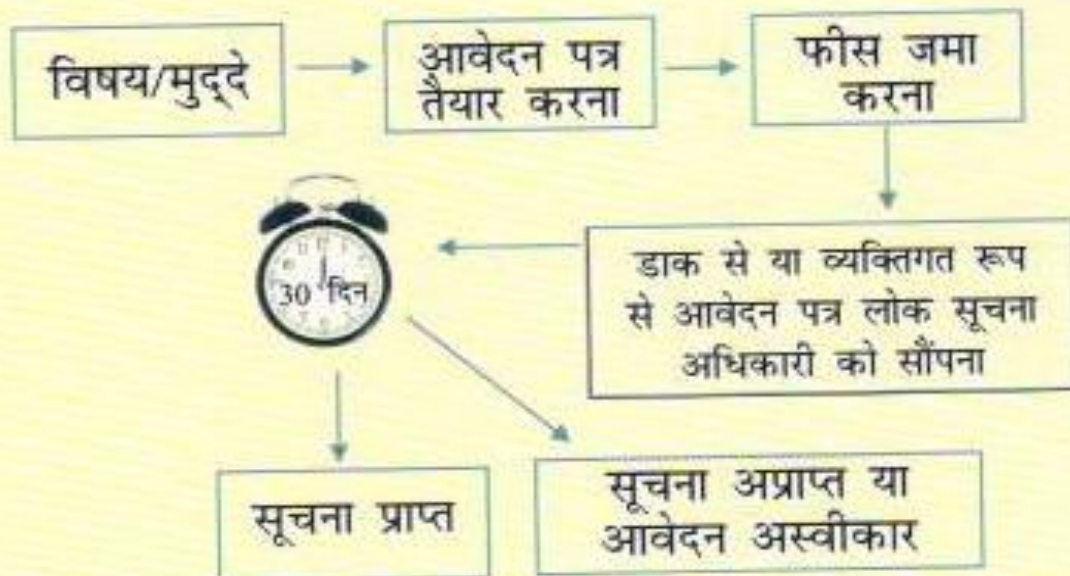
1. भारत का कोई भी नागरिक सूचना का अधिकार अधिनियम 2005 के अंतर्गत सूचना प्राप्त कर सकता है। इसके लिए उसे किसी भी प्रकार कारण बताने की जरूरत नहीं है।
2. आवेदक को भी अपने बारे में कोई जानकारी नहीं देनी होती है सिवाय उस पते के जिस पर सूचना अधिकारी सूचना भेज सके।

### आवेदन हेतु निर्धारित शुल्क:

- केन्द्र सरकार ने सूचना प्राप्त करने हेतु आवेदन शुल्क 10 रु निर्धारित किया है, परंतु हरियाणा में यह शुल्क 50 रु है, बी.पी.एल. कार्ड धारकों को आवेदन शुल्क नहीं देना होता व ऐसे आवेदकों को अपने आवेदन के साथ कार्ड की छायाप्रति भी लगानी होती है।

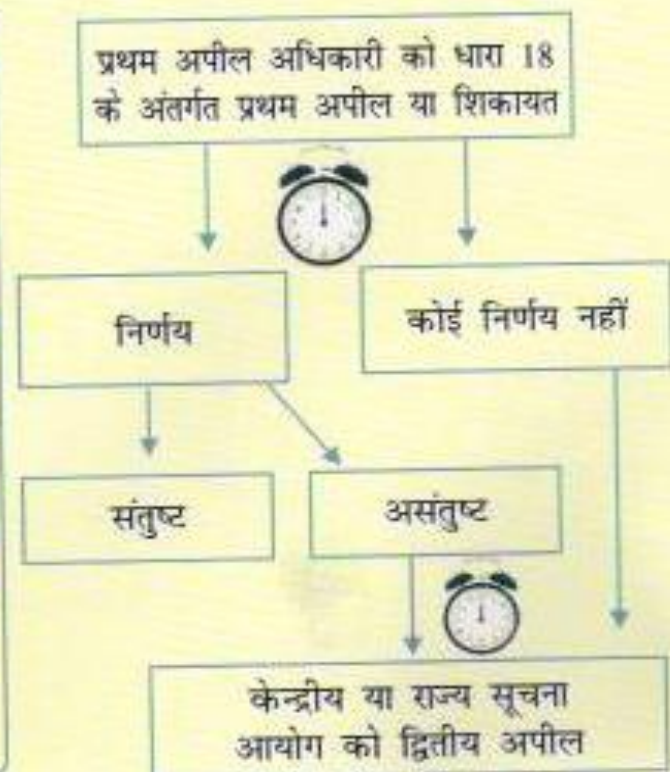

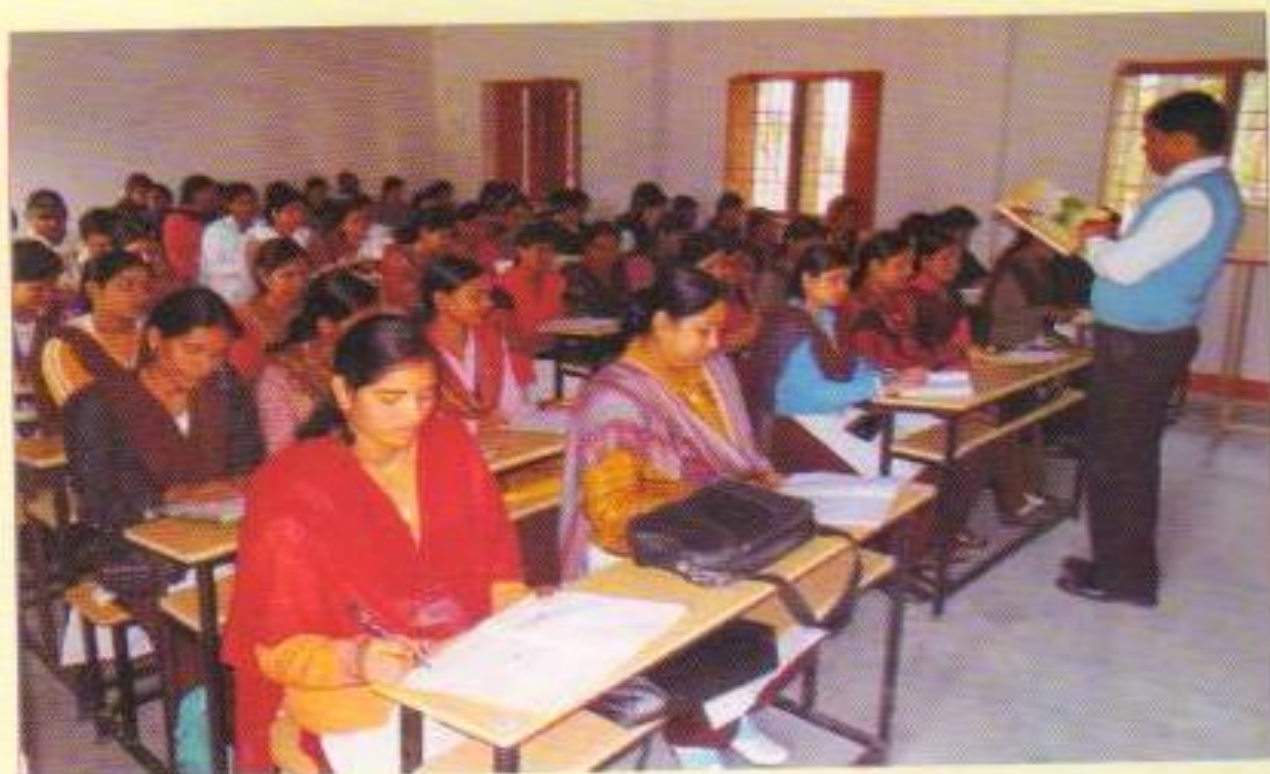
